

Convention Speakers Announced

The NCALC 2020 Annual Convention will feature an educational session with two experienced industry executives sharing their insights about the state of the industry today and explore how we can prosper going forward, despite COVID-19. Our speakers are Jon Meijer, Membership Director of Drycleaning and Laundry Institute (DLI) in Maryland, and Peter Blake, executive director of four regional drycleaning associations (NEFA, SEFA, MAC and CCA). Meijer and Blake will each draw on over 30 years of experience working in the Fabricare Industry, to give us an update on the industry and share insights about navigating the challenges imposed by COVID-19 and gaining advantage from the opportunities ahead.
